**Information about Wethersfield Senior League
2008 Season
Babe Ruth**

New this year, all players (except those participating on a High School Baseball Team) will participate in

preseason Clinics and Evaluations. These clinics are intended to help the new players with the transition from the Little League Field to the larger Babe Ruth Field and to improve skills of the returning players. The \$30 fee will be used to cover costs of using Baseball City for Hitting and Pitching Clinics. There will be six Clinic/Evaluation sessions held between Monday April 21, 2008 and Saturday, May 10, 2008

The **Regular Season** will begin in May and finish at the end of June. Those players assigned to a team last year will still be part of a team. New players will be selected through the Clinic/Evaluation Process. This is done to give everyone some time to work on their baseball skills and provide a fair opportunity to showcase their skills. Each player will be supplied a jersey, hat, belt and socks, [which they will return the Jersey and belts only]. Each player will supply his or her own **white** baseball pants. Fee: \$100.00

* Note: If a new player does not participate in the Clinic/Evaluation process he/she will not be a candidate for the regular season rosters. Exceptions: A new player that has played in the High School Program, an injury that has kept the player from participating in the Clinic/Evaluation process. The Board of Directors will address all others.

Jaycee Courant

The Jaycee Courant program is a very competitive program, which will begin in June, and end towards the end of July or early August. There are two divisions and one team in each division. The divisions are broken down to Prep (13 year olds only) and Juniors (14-15 year olds only). To be accepted in this program you **MUST** tryout each year. Each player will be supplied a jersey, pants, hat, belt and socks, [which they will return the Jersey, pants and belts only]. Tryouts will be in late May or Early June at a field and Time TBD. Please check local papers for announcements of tryouts.

Fee Examples: At Sign-ups

Player 1: First time player – Pays \$30.00 for Clinics/Evaluations. Plus pay \$100.00 for regular season. If not selected, \$100.00 will be returned. Total at sign ups: \$130.00

Player 2: Played last year. Pays \$30.00 for Clinics/Evaluations and \$100.00 for Regular season. Total at sign ups \$130.00

Player 3: Played last year but will be playing at the High School: Pays \$100.00 for regular season

Reminder: At all Babe Ruth Levels, players will be responsible for procuring their own WHITE baseball pants.

Please note: Parents – Please refrain from discussing your child’s performance before and after games or practices. This time is reserved for players only. If you wish to have a discussion, please contact your coach or manager via telephone to set up a time.

Any returned checks: Applicant to pay League Fees plus return charge of \$20.00.
